World UAV Federation Charter

I. World UAV Federation (WUAVF) Charter is the basic document of this organization.

The document is defined and structured by the internal rules and the Code of Ethics of WUAVF.

The action of WUAVF must be based on integrity, justice, mutual respect and the principle of serving WUAVF.

The regulation of the WUAVF is as follows: establish the industry standard for UAV industry, promote the development of UAV industry, drive the innovation of UAV technology and products, cooperate with the government's guidance and management of the industry, protect the legitimate rights and interests of member companies and forge a harmonious order of market competition.

Drone companies and professionals must obey the Code of Ethics which was established by WUAVF. WUAVF organizes the cooperation and mutual assistance between different drone companies and technical professionals. WUAVF represents, promotes and spreads the knowledge and principles about UAV technology, standard, training, service, management and operation.

Π .Tasks and Goals

1. Mission. WUAVF is an international organization of drone companies and drone professionals, and is committed to promoting the development of drone industry and technology.

2. The goal. WUAVF has established professional and ethical standards for the development of UAV industry. It provides advice, promotes training, promotes technological development, and raises public awareness of laws through global networks and cooperation projects for drone technology and service activities.

III . Membership

1. Member. Drone companies, drone professionals, and other individuals or groups that are considered to be useful in advancing the development of the UAV industry are eligible to become members of WUAVF.

All individuals who up to the membership standard should indicate to WUAVF that they want to join in the membership, and they should accept and obey the Code of Ethics of WUAVF, and complete the membership application form.

2. The permission of membership. Each international chapter should submit the application form of new members and annual fee to WUAVF Secretariat as soon as possible.

IV. Voting Right

1. Right. WUAVF enacts a rule on the voting right for Individual members and group members on General Assembly and Executive Committee. During the voting period, the member who presents at the conference can and can only represent one client.

2. National Committee vote. National committee or international committee have the right to designate five members of the committee (individual members or representatives of designated group members) to vote on behalf of the committee in matters that are submitted to General Assembly for voting.

3. The affiliated organization vote. An affiliated organization has the right to designate three members (individual members or representatives of designated group members) to vote on behalf of the organization in the matters that are submitted to General Assembly.

4. Nonvoting members. Sponsoring members and honorary members do not have voting rights in General Assembly.

Mr. Aziz co-chaired the UN Secretary General Committee to promote reform and coherence at the United Nations. As Prime Minister, Mr. Aziz paid state visits to China in 2004 and 2007. Mr. Aziz offers an expert view and is a frequent speaker on the challenges facing the world including structural reforms, diplomacy, geopolitics and security. Mr. Aziz is a member of several boards and advisory boards of various commercial and non-profit entities around the world. In 2015, Mr. Aziz became one of the board members of Boao Forum For Asia.



Yukio Hatoyama

Former Prime Minister of Japan

Mr. Yukio Hatoyama, born 11 February 1947, is a former Japanese politician who served as Prime Minister of Japan from 16 September 2009 to 8 June 2010. He was the first Prime Minister from the modern Democratic Party of Japan.

First elected to the House of Representatives in 1986, Hatoyama became President of the DPJ, the main opposition party, in May 2009. He then led the party to victory in the August 2009 general election, defeating the long-governing Liberal Democratic Party (LDP), who had been in power for over a decade. He represented the Hokkaido 9th district in the House of Representatives from 1986 to 2012.



Ante Glibota

Mr. Ante Glibota, Vice-Chairman of the European Academy of Sciences, Arts and Letters (EASAL), economist, art and architectural historian and author. As author and publisher of over 220 books and catalogues, devoted to contemporary art, architecture and literature he has created many rare books in limited editions with important contemporary artists and poets. He also wrote a volume of poetry, illustrated by the artists.

He was appointed Chevalier de l'Ordre des Arts et des Lettres (France, 1987) and received the 'Distinction Marko Marulić ', the highest award for cultural achievement of the Republic of Croatia in 1996, as well as the Order of National Flag in the same year. Since 2010 until 2016 he serves as Vice-President and Curator-in-Chief of the Museum of Art and Urbanity in Shanghai, China. In Year 2019, Ante Glibota was appointed as Honorary Chairman of the World UAV Drone Federation, Shenzhen, China.



Bi Zhengqing

Mr. Bi Zhengqing, French Chinese, bass singer of French National Radio Choir, and academician of the European Academy of Sciences Arts and Letters in France. In 1983, Bi Zhengqing came to France with his wife after graduating from the Central Conservatory of Music. In the days of France, with the establishment of the Yellow River Art Troupe, Bi Zhengqing took the group to perform in European countries, and then entered the French National Radio Choir and founded the European Institute of Daoyi to spread the Chinese Taoist culture.



Rob Thompson

Mr. Rob Thompson holds a Master of Science from James Madison University for his work in aviation system designs and technical & scientific writing. Rob is also the founder of Falcon Foundation UAS L.L.C. who provides leading advocacy efforts in the unmanned aircraft systems industry, managing government relations, committees of association, executing legislative and regulatory strategies and creating law through the corresponding legislative committees. Rob's past projects for research and innovation include: C-UAS, flight instrument haptic sensing, infrared runway traffic signals, pilot selection process, positive attributes of pilots, application development, UAV development, advanced display systems, robotics, wearables, 3D printing, advanced manufacturing, data collection and sensors. Rob also has flight experience in 80 different models of aircraft and flown professionally as an ISR pilot, skydive operations, general aviation transport and aerial image operations.



Kenzo Nonami

Dr. Kenzo Nonami has been a full professor in Department of Mechanical Engineering at Chiba University since 1994. Dr. Kenzo Nonami was in charge of Vice President of Chiba University from 2008 to 2013. Right now, Dr. Nonami is an emeritus professor at Chiba University, CEO of his company called "Autonomous Control Systems Laboratory, Ltd." and a Chairman of Japan Drone Consortium which includes more than 300 companies. His recent research interests are fully autonomous drones, namely, fully autonomous unmanned multi-rotor helicopters and VTOLs as UAVs with GPS or GPS-denied environments, advanced robotics and mechatronics.



Christoph Strecha

Dr. Christoph Strecha is the CEO and founder of Pix4D, a Swiss company which develops and markets software for production of survey grade 3D models and orthomosaics from images. Strecha received a PhD from the Catholic University of Leuven (Belgium) in 2008, completing his thesis on multi-view stereo. His research interests include structure and motion techniques and city modeling. He was and is involved in the work of several Commissions of the International Society for Photogrammetry and Remote Sensing. He has authored numerous papers and in 2015 received the Carl Pulfrich Award for his work in computer vision and photogrammetry.






Drone World Congress 2019



[Better Technology Better Life] The 3rd Drone World Congress was held at the OCT Intercontinental Hotel and Convention Center in Shenzhen respectively on June 20-22. The conference was based on the theme of Security Supervision, Technological Innovation, and Intelligent Application. It consists of four parts: forum, exhibition, selection and competition, including a main conference, 30 parallel forums, 22,500 square meters of international exhibitions, three competitions, and the Global UAV Contribution Award Ceremony. More than 30 speeches were given by 300 experts, scholars, and corporate leaders to promote the innovation of the UAV industry in Shenzhen, China and the World.

In recognition of the outstanding contributions to the global development of the UAV industry, the Drone World Congress Organizing Committee held the award ceremony of "the Second Contribution Award of Drone World Congress" on June 20, 2019.

Events



On February 13th, 2018, Euan Yao, the assistant to the Chairman of Shenzhen UAV Industry Association, met with Mr. Jani, the co-founder of ArduPilot in Bangkok. They had a deep communication on the cooperation between ArduPilot and the World UAV Federation. During the discussion, Mr. Jani confirmed that in June this year, he would lead the global experts from his federation to attend Shenzhen International UAV EXPO 2018 which would be held by Shenzhen UAV Industry Association, and he would then unveil ArduPilot Conference for the first time in Drone World Congress.


On July 7, 2019, President of Daegu University of South Korea met with the delegation of Shenzhen UAV Industry Association led by Chiarman Yang Jincai..
